


STUDENTS FEEDBACK (First years) 2017



Analysis of academic feedback:

- 1) From the analysis it can be interpreted that students 32 are satisfied with the effectiveness of the course handout, 119 students have agreed on the teacher's knowledge and the syllabus going alongside the course handouts, only 10 students disagreed on it.
- 2) 124 students are completely satisfied with the examples used on the particular topic and overall presentation making them prepare for the semester exams by revising them with accurate syllabus related question in the class 37 agreed on the right communication skills and questions prepared for them for the exams.
- 3) As per the graph 76 students responded excellent on the Analysis on punctuality of teachers and 80 students responded good with the utilization of teaching time.

- 4) 120 students rated excellent on the effective methods used to make classes interesting, 41 students good on teachers imparting meaning lectures. Most of the teachers have already included modern teaching aids in teaching. They have started preparing power point presentation and other innovative teaching aids to stimulate the students for better understanding. Two visually disabled faculty members are unable to use teaching aids perfectly but still they try to include innovative teaching methods with the help of their research scholars.
- 5) From the above graph 76 of the students expressed very well on teachers being very cooperative, accessible and very helpful and cooperative.

Analysis of administration feedback:

- 1) From the graph it can be interpreted that 35 students responded on the effectiveness of college IRP/app, 76 students responded the app good and 50 students are not quite satisfied.
- 2) 54 Students also expressed their satisfaction towards the initiatives & efforts which office department takes from time to time for the improvement of monitoring standards and quality of research.
- 3) From the above analysis 99 of students are satisfied with the promptness and performance of office work, 52 gave good analysis and 9 students disagreed.
- 4) 84 students gave excellent feedback on the security staff being professional and 61 students agree on the perfect execution of the security and only 16 disagreed on it.
- 5) From the above graph the students 110 responded the information center providing them accurate information and 32 students and agreed upon whereas only 19 the students disagreed.

Analysis on library/sports/cafeteria:

- 1) From the graph 110 students utilize the library and make use of educational online resources and 34 responded on the library and only 24 students were dissatisfied.
- 2) 100 students responded excellent on the internet facility provided in the library and 32 responded good and 29 did not agree on it.
- 3) On the overall impression of the college library 108 responded excellent on the college library, 46 students responded well and 7 students disagreed.
- 4) From the above analysis 85 students expressed their satisfaction on the overall equipment on staff and sports room during the college hours, 23 students responded on the development of the equipments and 53 responded emphasized on the dissatisfaction.

- 5) On the sports equipment majority of students by 83 showed concern and dissatisfaction on the insufficient equipments on sports, and 60 of them showed concern on the matter and 18 expressed were positive.
- 6) From the analysis on the physical director 92 the students expressed positive results being very encouraging and supportive and 24 were satisfied and 45 rated dissatisfied.
- 7) From the analysis 98 rated well on cafeteria, 33 rated good on the food being hygiene and only 32 emphasized on few changes.

Analysis on counseling feedback:

- 1) On the analysis of the college counselor 64 of students felt very helpful on having a counselor 35 responded well and 62 students did not feel the need.
- 2) From the above analysis the students rated 105 of them expressed satisfaction on the counselors being encouraging and supportive to them and 43 agreed on it and 11 of them showed concern.
- 3) On the basis of the counselor being effective 113 of students responded well and 29% responded excellent and only 17 of students showed concern on improvement.

Recommendations:

1. More access to the library during college hours and beyond needs to be accorded to the students, the desktop systems need to be repaired. A number of students complained about the inefficiency of the college App and expressed negative views on the SMS being sent to the parents for hourly attendance. Some suggesting improvements in the App and features like assignments to be given before hand through the IRP. The 75% mandatory attendance rule got its fair share of censure.
2. Students deserve to understand and enjoy rich learning environments which entail creating meaningful formal developments and other opportunities for teachers to improve more and implement practices that nurture cultures of learning for students.



STUDENTS FEEDBACK (Final years)2017



Analysis of academic feedback:

- 1) From the analysis it can be interpreted that 8 students are satisfied with the effectiveness of the course handout, 91 students have agreed on the teacher's knowledge and the syllabus going alongside the course handouts, only 31 students did not find course handout effective.
- 2) From the above graph 87 students are completely satisfied with the examples used on the particular topic and overall presentation making them prepare for the semester exams by revising them with accurate syllabus related question in the class 46 agreed on the right communication skills and questions prepared for them for the exams and zero students did not find any fault.
- 3) As per the graph 88 students responded excellent on the Analysis on punctuality of teachers and 36 students responded good with the utilization of teaching time and 15 students only found fault in the punctuality.

- 4) 85 students rated excellent on the effective methods used to make classes interesting, 48 students good on teachers imparting meaning lectures. Most of the teachers have already included modern teaching aids in teaching. They have started preparing power point presentation and other innovative teaching aids to stimulate the students for better understanding and none found any fault.
- 5) From the above graph 85 of the students expressed very well on teachers being very cooperative, 41 students responded accessible and very helpful and cooperative, 8 students only were not satisfied.

Analysis of administration feedback:

- 1) A number of students complained about the inefficiency of the college App and expressed negative views on the SMS being sent to the parents for hourly attendance. About 85 of them complained on it and 40 were satisfied and 9 responded excellent some suggesting improvements in the App and features like assignments to be given before hand through the IRP. The 75% mandatory attendance rule got its fair share of censure
- 2) About 93 Students expressed their satisfaction towards the initiatives & efforts which office department takes from time to time for the improvement and 17 responded on maintaining the monitoring standards and quality of research and only 24 students had problem.
- 3) From the above analysis 81 of students are satisfied with the promptness and performance of office work, 24 gave good analysis and 29 students disagreed.
- 4) From the above graph 59 students gave excellent feedback on the security staff being professional and 38 students agree on the perfect execution of the security and only 37 disagreed on it.
- 5) From the above graph the students 80 responded the information center providing them accurate information and 23 students and agreed upon whereas only 31 the students disagreed.

Analysis on library/sports/cafeteria:

- 1) A considerable number of students about 42 expressed the need for increasing the number of titles that would expand the collection in terms of novels, short stories, biographies, textbooks, magazines, books on psychology, media, filmmaking along with documentaries, biopic and other resources etc. Some even commented on the space constraints of the present library and 78 had no concern and 23 were satisfied with the library books.
- 2) About 78 students responded excellent on the internet facility provided in the library and 12 responded good and only 4 of them did not agree on it.

- 3) From the above analysis 25 students responded excellent and 80 students had no issues with the library and only 23 of them voiced on concern about the limited access on the resources provided in the library.
- 4) From the above analysis 12 students expressed their satisfaction on the overall equipment on staff and sports room during the college hours, 59 students responded on the development of the equipments and 62 responded emphasized on the dissatisfaction of library staff being rude and unfriendly.
- 5) On the sports equipment majority of students by 64 showed concern and dissatisfaction on the insufficient equipments on sports, and 59 of them showed concern on the matter and 10 expressed were positive.
- 6) From the analysis on the physical director 75 the students expressed positive results being very encouraging and supportive and 17 were satisfied and 39 rated dissatisfied and voiced out the limited opportunities and services of the sports room may not be available or open to the girls as much as the boys according to some responses. Sports resources and activities not adequately available to girls. There is a need for inclusion and encouragement for girls in this respect.
- 7) From the analysis 82 rated well on cafeteria, 20 rated good on the food being hygiene and only 32 emphasized on few changes.

Analysis on counseling feedback:

- 1) On the analysis of the college counselor 32 of students felt very helpful on having a counselor 39 responded well and 60 students did not feel the need.
- 2) From the above analysis the students rated 69 of them expressed satisfaction on the counselors being encouraging and supportive to them and 19 agreed on it and 33 of them showed concern with the counselor being less supportive with them.
- 3) On the basis of the counselor being effective 70 of students responded well and 14 responded excellent and only 37 of students showed concern on improvement.

Recommendations:

1. Classroom decorum is to be maintained by the teachers so as to create the right environment that is conducive to learning.
2. There should be deliberate efforts made towards making the female students feel welcome, and equal opportunity should be given to them in all sports activities.
3. The administrative staff and front office should be courteous in dealing with students at the counters and avoid unnecessary delays.
